ALL YOUR FAVOURITE FUNPARK RIDES:

Luna Park Sydney has everyone's favourite rides from the 1930s right through to the 21st century:

- **Coney Island** – one of the Park's original buildings, Coney Island has loads of nostalgic charm with its 1930s murals and rides including Giant Slides, Joy Wheel, Ye Olde Turkey Trot and Barrels of Fun.
- **'White Knuckle Rides'** – include the Tumble Bug, Rotor, Wild Mouse, UFO, Ranger, Spider, Ferris Wheel, Tango Train and Dodgems.
- **Children's Rides** – Maloney's Corner is perfect for the littlest of Park visitors with the U-Drive, Space Shuttle, Magic Castle and Whirly Wheel.
- **Rides for all** – everyone can enjoy the magic of the beautifully restored 1894 English Carousel featuring galloping horses and cockerels, or take in the spectacular views from the Ferris Wheel.

A HUGE RANGE OF THINGS TO SEE:

For those who want more than rides, Luna Park has some very unique offerings including:

- **Street performers** – on the weekends and during school holidays, the Park midway comes alive with a range of entertainers including clowns, jugglers, and Park mascots Lunabob and Lunabelle.
- **Taj Mahal** – one of the largest and most elaborate mechanical musical instruments in the world, the Taj Mahal was built in 1920 and has more than 1200 pipes, drums, castanets and woodblocks.
- **Park Art** – Luna Park has a crazy selection of artworks, from Arthur Barton's murals in Coney Islands, to current artist-in-resident Ashley Taylor's work-in-progress throughout the Park.

Nestled within all the atmosphere and fun of Luna Park are a range of five star venues:

- **Big Top** – a 3000 capacity performance space catering for a wide range of seated and unseated events including live music, circus, performance and physical theatre.
- **Yarraman Crystal Palace** – a 1300 capacity function venue ideal for conferences, weddings, cocktail parties etc.
- **Popcorn Hall** – a smaller function venue perfect for children's birthdays and informal parties.
