



## The Wild Mouse at Luna Park Sydney

What better way to see the Harbour Bridge, Sydney Opera House and the rest of Luna Park than from the Wild Mouse. But you have to be quick – the two-person cars zip around the quarter-mile track in one minute flat!

The plans for The Wild Mouse, one of the oldest rides on site, were bought by Luna Park at Seattle Trade Fair. In 1962 it was constructed on the top of the cliff at Luna Park. With its gravity-fed design from Mack of Germany, it was one of the world's most popular roller coasters in the 1950s and '60s. There are now only five still operating, three of which are in Australia.

Throughout the 1960s, 70s and 80s when Luna Park closed for the winter months, the Wild Mouse was dismantled and re-constructed at the annual Sydney Royal Easter Show and Royal Queensland Show.

The structure of the Wild Mouse is made from imported Oregon Pine, while the 1/4-mile track is made of laminated Oregon Pine. Long-time Park employee Tony Maloney and his dedicated team spent two years restoring the Wild Mouse leading up to the 2004 reopening of Luna Park. The ride still has its original 12 cars, with up to four on the track at any one time.

### Ride Photos

Dare to ride the Wild Mouse and take home the photo to prove it.
